Purpose

To advise the Committee of actions taken under delegated authority since the last meeting

Background or Current Position

1. There has been one occasion since the last meeting of the Committee where it has been necessary for officers to take urgent action. This was actioned after consultation with the Chairman of the Committee and Head of Service. The matter related to the Street Collection application for the Royal British Legion Poppy Appeal. The Urgent Action Report is attached as Annex 1.
2. Under the current street collections policy, the Royal British Legion has a specified category giving exact day on which they can collect. The Camberley branch of the Royal British Legion do not collect past the 11th November and as such, needed to amend two of the days in the policy. The current street collections policy does not allow officers to amend collection days.
