Dear Rob

I thank you for your e-mail of 1 July upon which I have now taken Morrison's instructions. I can confirm that Morrisons would be agreeable to reducing the hours for the supply of alcohol to 0600 to 2300 and to the following conditions being attached to the licence:-

1. An electronic refusals system will be in place.
2. Appropriate digital CCTV equipment and a sufficient number of cameras shall be installed and maintained at the premises to record colour images of an evidential quality. The areas covered by the cameras will cover all areas within the premises that are open to the public. A camera will be positioned to obtain images of persons entering the building by the main entrances. These images shall be of evidential quality.
3. The CCTV system will be in operation and recording whenever the premises are open to the public.
4. Recordings made on the CCTV system shall be retained for a period of at least 30 days of recording.
5. Notices stating that CCTV is in operation shall be displayed throughout the premises where the public have access and the notices shall be at least A4 size.

I would be grateful if you would confirm that on the basis of the amendment to hours and the conditions referred to above your representation will be withdrawn.
