


**REPRESENTATION FROM THE HEAD OF COMMUNITY WITH RESPECT TO AN APPLICATION UNDER THE LICENSING ACT 2003**

Type of application: Application for a premises license

I hereby submit this representation, because in my opinion the application does not adequately address the following licensing objectives:  The Prevention of Public Nuisance
The reasons for my opinion are:  <u>With respect to (licensing objective)</u>  <u>The Prevention of Public Nuisance</u>  There is no mention in the application of controls to be implemented to ensure that noise created as a result of activities to be carried out at The Cambridge Hotel does not represent a public nuisance.  It is noted that the application excludes the premises currently known as Club121 as a separate application is to be submitted for the Club 121 premises due to the hours of operation and noise breakout.  We would wish the following wording to be included as a condition on the new licence for The Cambridge Hotel:-  "Noise emanating from the premises as a result of regulated entertainment shall not exceed 59dBLaeq over any 15 minute period at a distance of 1 metre from any residential premises."
