## Annex 1 – Mandatory conditions

1. S19

i) No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence -

(a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or at

(b) a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.

ii) Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

## **Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the operating Schedule**

1. The licence holder shall co-operate with the police and authorised officers of the Council when necessary to prevent crime and disorder.
2. The sale of food shall be conducted in accordance with food and safety guidelines.
3. No activities shall be undertaken at the premises which would cause noise disturbance to the public.
4. Any person appearing to be under the age of 21 years who wishes to purchase alcohol shall be required to provide appropriate identification to verify their age.
