# HACKNEY CARRIAGE FARES - PROPOSED FARE SCALE

Portfolio: Community

Ward(s) Affected: All

#### **Purpose**

To consider proposals for increasing fares for the hire of hackney carriages.

#### Background

1. The Council is empowered by Section 65 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 to fix the rate of fares for hackney carriages that it licenses. The fare can include charges for time and distance and other charges that may be made in relation to hiring a hackney carriage. The last increase in hackney carriage fares was implemented in July 2006. Consultations took place with hackney carriage proprietors and drivers in 2007 with regard to increasing fares but with the exception of one proprietor the responses that were received indicated that proprietors and drivers did not wish fares to be increased at that time.

#### **Current Position**

- 2. Following large increases in fuel prices over the last 12 months a request was received earlier this year from five hackney carriage proprietors/drivers requesting that fares be increased and following consultations with the drivers and proprietors concerned it was agreed that a more general meeting would be held to discuss the proposals that they had submitted. Unfortunately very few people who were invited to participate in this meeting attended to discuss the proposals but all those who were present did concur with the fare scale that was proposed at that meeting. Details of increases in the cost of living and other costs that are peculiar to running a hackney carriage or private hire vehicle (ie insurance, vehicle maintenance etc) were not submitted in support of the application for a fare increase. The setting of fares is however to a certain extent a business decision by proprietors requiring Council approval. In this respect the Council needs to maintain a careful balance between increasing fares to compensate for increased costs in running a taxi, the interests of the public and ensuring that the fares charged will not deter people from using taxis.
- 3. The proposals that were agreed were advertised in accordance with Section 65 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 and a petition was subsequently received from 37 drivers requesting that the charges proposed for distance travelled should be further increased. A copy of the proposed fare scale is attached at Annex A and a copy of the petition is attached at Annex B.
- 4. Members may wish to note that many of the people who have signed this petition declined an invitation to attend the meeting when these proposals were discussed. The Vice-Chairman of the Licensing Committee was also present at these discussions.
- 5. Under the proposals that have been advertised the fare for the first mile of any journey would be increased by 33% and for each mile thereafter by 11%. The petition proposes that the fare for each mile travelled after the first mile should be increased to 22%.

- 6. A chart showing fares for given distances under the existing fare table, the proposed fare table and the further increases that are now being sought is shown in Annex C. A chart showing comparable fares for adjoining local authority areas also shown in Annex C. The proposals that have been advertised make provision for the charge for waiting time to be increased from £17.20 to £18.00 per hour but no amendments have been sought to this proposal.
- 7. Those people who have submitted the petition have been requested to provide detailed information in support of their application for the additional increase and a further report on this matter will be submitted at the meeting.
- 8. The implementation date for the fare scale previously approved has been postponed to enable the proposals put forward in the petition to be considered by the Committee and other taxi drivers and proprietors have been advised accordingly. A limited response has been received from a number of taxi drivers/proprietors indicating that they do not wish the fare scale to be increased further as they feel that it will deter people from using taxis and would have a negative impact on their business interest. Letters from two proprietors concerning this matter are attached at Annex D.
- 9. The original representations made requesting a fare increase and the preamble to the petition emphasise the impact that the increase in fuel prices has on their business costs. It is estimated that fuel prices have in fact increased by in the region of 70% since 2006 and with fuel prices continuing to increase it is likely that this may eventually reach 100%.

#### Proposal

10. The fare scale as advertised already proposes substantial increases in fares and the charges are in fact comparable to those charged by adjoining local authority areas. In supplying additional information it has been suggested that there has been further substantial increases since the proposals that have been advertised were agreed in April, particularly in relation to fuel, maintenance and insurance charges. Fuel prices are continuing to rise but there is no reason to believe that maintenance charges and insurance costs are rising at a comparable rate and there have been no substantial increases in the last month. Accordingly it is proposed that the fare scale as advertised be confirmed.

#### **Options**

11. The Committee has the option of setting the fare scale at a level which it considers to be appropriate and although any decision taken by the Council cannot be challenged in court, it is recognised that any changes to the fare scale should be undertaken in consultation with taxi proprietors and drivers. Such consultations have now taken place and there is some conflict between views which have been expressed with regard to fare levels. The Committee has the option of retaining the existing fare scale without amendment, increasing fares in line with the requests made in the petition or to make any such other amendments as are considered appropriate.

#### **Resource Implications**

12. There are no additional cost implications arising from the proposals.

#### Recommendation

13. The Committee is advised to RESOLVE that the fare scale as set out in Annex A be approved without amendment.

# HACKNEY CARRIAGE AND PRIVATE HIRE VEHICLE DRIVER CHECKS

Portfolio: Community

Ward(s) Affected: All

#### **Purpose**

To consider the setting of fees for undertaking hackney carriage and private hire vehicle driver licence checks.

#### Background

1. The Committee, at its meeting on 5<sup>th</sup> December 2007, approved procedures for undertaking checks of DVLA licences held by applicants for licences to drive hackney carriage and private hire vehicles. The Committee was also asked to consider the fee which should be charged for undertaking these licence checks and resolved that reports be prepared on the fees and charges structure of hackney carriage and private hire licences and on the procedures available to the Council to check EU licences for evidence of fraud.

#### **Current Position**

- 2. An account has now been opened with the DVLA to commence undertaking driver licence checks and the proposals for undertaking these checks will be implemented in the near future. The charge imposed by the DVLA for undertaking each check will be £5.00.
- 3. The form which will be completed by applicants to obtain the check is attached at Annex A. The time spent by officers in undertaking these checks will involve sending the form to the DVLA, checking the information which is received and monitoring payments into the DVLA account. It is estimated that the total time spent on carrying out each check will be between five and ten minutes.
- 4. A copy of the fee structure which has been approved by the Council in relation to hackney carriage and private hire licence fees is attached at Annex B. Under the provisions of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 the Council is only entitled to charge fees to the extent that it recovers the cost of the licensing function and any enforcement undertaken. The fees that are already charged are therefore intended to cover the costs of officers employed in this service and other support charges.
- 5. No additional resources will be provided to undertake the driver licence checks although there will be some stationary costs. It is estimated that a charge of £1in addition to the fee charged by the DVLA would be sufficient to recover the costs incurred by the Council.
- 6. Enquiries have also been made regarding the possibility of undertaking driver licence checks in respect of EU licences provided by applicants. No EU licences have been submitted or accepted over the last 12 months and consequently no problems have arisen in connection with such licences. The DVLA do not carry out checks in respect of licences issued by EU countries and recommend that if a check is required it should be carried out with the issuing authority in the country concerned. Such

checks can be undertaken but the cost involved in respect of each particular country are unknown and it would involve sending individual letters to the relevant licensing authority.

#### Proposal

7. Officers propose that a fee of £6.00 should be charged in respect of all driver licence checks that are required to be undertaken in respect of applicants for hackney carriage and private hire vehicle driver licences.

#### **Options**

8. Alternative charges could be adopted but regard must be had to the provisions of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 which precludes the Council making excess income from undertaking this licensing function.

#### **Resource Implications**

9. There are no anticipated additional cost implications arising from this proposal.

#### Recommendation

10. The Committee is advised to RESOLVE that a fee of £6.00 be charged for undertaking hackney carriage and private hire vehicle driver licence checks with the DVLA and licensing authorities in EU countries.

# ENFORCEMENT – APPOINTMENT OF THE LICENSING ADMINISTRATOR AS AN AUTHORISED OFFICER

#### **Purpose**

To consider appointing the Licensing Administrator as an authorised officer for the purposes of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976, Town Police Clauses Act 1874, the Licensing Act 2003 and the Gambling Act 2005.

#### **Background**

- 1. The Council as a Licensing Authority is empowered to take enforcement action in respect of non-compliance with the requirements of;
  - Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976
  - Town Police Clauses Act 1847
  - Licensing Act 2003
  - Gambling Act 2005
  - and regulations made there under

#### **Current Position**

- 2. The Licensing Manager and the Licensing Officer have already been designated as authorised officers for the purpose of enforcing some sections of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976, Town Police Clauses Act 1847, the Licensing Act 2003 and the Gambling Act 2005. An "authorised officer" is defined as meaning any officer of a district council authorised in writing by the Council for the purposes of these parts of these Acts.
- 3. A recent risk assessment has identified the need for inspections and enforcement action to be undertaken by officers working in pairs particularly when this involves working during out of hours or late at night. On these occasions the police are also kept informed of the whereabouts of officers.
- 4. The job description of the Licensing Administrator includes assisting with enforcement work but she has not yet been appointed in writing to undertake this role. In addition to enforcement work the Licensing Administrator also undertakes the sealing of hackney carriage meters which involves out of office lone working in vehicles which are to be licensed and with drivers who may not be licensed.
- In addition to permitting the Licensing Administrator to assist with enforcement action her appointment as an authorised officer does provide some legal protection. Although it does not remove the risk of physical confrontation the penalties for obstructing an authorised officer of the Council are severe and may deter some forms of confrontation.

#### Proposal

6. For the purposes of carrying out enforcement it is proposed that the Licensing Administrator should be appointed as an authorised officer under Part II of the Local

Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976, the Town Police Clauses Act 1847, the Licensing Act 2003 and the Gambling Act 2005.

#### Recommendation

7. The Committee is invited to RESOLVE, that for the purposes of carrying out enforcement work, the Licensing Administrator be appointed as an authorised officer under Part II of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976, the Town Police Clauses Act 1847, the Licensing Act 2003 and the Gambling Act 2005.

#### Background

1. Details of decisions taken under delegated powers in relation to applications, representations etc have to be reported to the Licensing Committee in accordance with the provisions of the Licensing Act 2003.

#### **Current Position**

- In accordance with the provisions of the Licensing Act 2003 powers have been delegated to the Head of Legal and Corporate Services and the Licensing Manager to determine applications for premises licences, club premises certificates and personal licences where no representations have been received from responsible authorities or interested parties.
- 3. If representations are received, it is decided whether representations are relevant and not vexatious or frivolous and have been submitted in accordance with statutory requirements. No representations have been rejected on these grounds since the last report on these matters to the Committee.
- 4. When representations have been received powers are delegated to the Adjudication Sub-Committee to determine the licence following consideration of these representations. A summary of the decisions of the hearings held by the Adjudication Sub-Committee are set out separately at Annex A.
- 5. A summary of the decisions that have been taken in respect of applications that have been considered and determined since the last meeting of the Committee is attached at Annex B. These details are submitted for information only and do not require ratification by the Committee.
