06/LS Adam's Kebab Van, Wilton Road, Camberley

The Sub Committee considered an application submitted by Adem Coskun in respect of a variation to the premises licence at Adam's Kebab Van, Wilton Road, Camberley.

The Sub-Committee was addressed by the Licensing Officer and was advised that the variation was for the extension of the hours to provide late night refreshments.

Mrs Tzivelek informed the Sub Committee that the applicant had considered residents' concerns about litter and noise nuisance and had agreed to provide

extra waste bins within the vicinity of the premises which would be emptied every night before closing. The applicant would also remind customers to leave the premises in a quiet manner. Members were advised that litter picking would be carried out every night by the applicant and his staff in a specified area around the premises which would include parts of Park Road. However, this was not supported by any management process.

Mr Pile representing himself and Mr Sanders and Mrs Lewis, informed the Sub Committee that the nuisance and litter had improved over the last few months. This had been due to the applicant trading for the hours as stated in his licence, following a complaint by the Police that he had been trading later than his licence allowed. The Sub Committee was advised that the noise nuisance and litter had been considerably bad during this period of unauthorised trading.

The Sub Committee retired to allow Members to consider their decision.

Having considered the application for a variation of the premises licence for Adam's Kebab Van, balancing the interests of the applicant and his business with the concerns of the Interested Parties, the Sub-Committee did not believe the applicant had addressed the resident's concerns and had not therefore promoted the required licensing objective. The Sub Committee did not accept that the additional conditions suggested by the applicant would overcome the matters raised by the representations and the extension of hours would create unreasonable disturbance to local residents. The application was therefore refused.

NOTED that the application for a variation of the premises licence for Adams Kebab Van be refused.
