

OPERATING SCHEDULE

1. Relevant Licensable Activities.

The relevant licensable activities which it is proposed to carry out at the premises include breakfasts meetings, luncheons, tea dances, dinners, suppers, indoor sports, conferences/seminars for business/religious/political/community gatherings, dancing competitions/displays, school proms, fashion exhibitions and sales, cabaret shows, charity fundraising, nationally recognised family occasions, birthday parties, christening parties, engagement parties, wedding parties, wakes, dinner dances, pantomimes, military tattoos, adult entertainment, music making, general dancing and the supply of alcohol.

2. Operating Times.

It is proposed that the licensed premises will continue to open for public and private events but between the new hours of 08.00am. (08.00hrs.) to 02.00am. (02.00hrs.) for all categories of activities seven days each week throughout the year.

3. Designated Premises Supervisor.

Mrs. Mary Brown is the Applicant's Designated Premises Supervisor (DPS).

4. The Supply of Alcohol.

It is proposed that the sale of alcohol at the licensed premises will be for consumption both ON and OFF the premises and will be dispensed in accordance with the provisions of the Licensing Act 2003 and the Premises Licence.

5. Promotion of the Licensing Objectives.

The four licensing objectives are promoted in the attachments to this Operating Schedule.

6. Additional Information.

The Operating Schedule comprises the Lakeside Events Schedule, Premises Management Plan, Safe Working Procedures, Risk Assessments and Premises Plan which are all attached.

7. The Premises.

The plan, attached to the Operating Schedule, to a scale of 1:150 dated May 2012 and marked drawing number 01 revision B, illustrates the extent of the licensed premises. It also shows the fire exits and bars together with the table dining layout in the main body of the auditorium.
