Further to our previous emails confirming object to the variation of the above license please would the Council accept this email as our formal objection to Lakeside Country Club's application.

The intensification of the use of the premises will without doubt increase vehicle movements, fireworks displays and drunken people leaving the premises. Lakeside is situated in a quiet residential area, it can already be quite rowdy in the evenings with people leaving the hotel as we are only protected by a thin hedge and falling down fence on the boundary of the hotel. With the intensification of use we are extremely concerned that the increase in capacity numbers will affect us and our family even more. Furthermore it is quite clear that the variation of the License and removing of restrictions such as allowing use of glass bottles will mean that the Licensing laws of objectives of

- The prevention of crime and disorder;
- Public safety;
- The prevention of public nuisance; and
- The protection of children from harm

Will be severely jeopardised.

We trust that Council will take our concerns into consideration and turn down the application.
