## Hi Patricia

The noise impact assessment demonstrates that noise levels from the plant extract is likely to be 5dB below the existing background levels when measured 1 metre in front of the nearest residential window. As such the impact is rated as low and I have no objections to the application. However the assessment uses typical plant noise and not that specific to the site. In these circumstances, and to ensure that noise breakout from plant within the building does not adversely affect residential above a condition would be appropriate. Such a condition would be;

Prior to commencement of work details of extraction plant serving the proposed to be submitted to and agreed in writing by the LPA.

Reason: To demonstrate that plant noise does not exceed 35dBa at 1 metre in front of nearest residential window, and that the power rating of any proposed installed plant does not exceed 65dBA when measured at 1 metre.
